Video Game Systems



Xbox One

- Visit [Microsoft.com/family](https://microsoft.com/family) and create an account or sign in
- Select the name of the child and select “screen time”
- Set up how much time the child is allowed to spend on this device and when they are allowed to use it

PlayStation 4

- Visit id.sonyentertainmentnetwork.com and create an account or sign in
- Select “account” then select “family management” and choose the account of the child who you would like to limit their access
- Select “edit” on the play time restrictions, make the changes you would like to change, then select “save” to apply all the changes

Nintendo Switch

- On the Nintendo Switch home screen launch up the "system settings."
- Scroll down and select "parental controls" and then click on "parental control settings" on the right hand side when prompted.
- The screen will then offer you restriction levels for that of a teen, a pre-teen, and a child. Select one of these settings and then select "custom settings" to configure parental control settings that you are comfortable with.

Cell Phones



Apple iPhone

- Go to your iPhone settings and select "screen time"
- Select "use screen time passcode" to create a four-digit passcode
- Select "app limits" the iPhone would then categorize certain apps under certain categories (Facebook would be under Social Networking, Candy Crush would be under Games, etc.) You can put a time limit on certain categories or you can put a time limit on all of them
- Upon clicking an app or a category that you would like to limit, choose the amount of time you would like to give that app or category
- When time is running out on the app you chose to limit the iPhone will send a reminder on how much time you have left on that app
- Once the time limit has been hit a white screen will pop up and cover the screen. If you made a passcode earlier, it will then ask you to enter the code to either dismiss the notification or extend the time

Samsung Galaxy

- Download the "Screen Time" app via the store
- Visit remote.screentimelabs.com on a web browser and sign up for an account or log in
- Enter the name of the child who you wish to set up an account for then select "Android" to find the instructions. Continue scrolling until you find a pairing code
- Open the "Screen Time" app on the phone and select the "get started" button found on the bottom
- The app will ask you if Screen Time is set up on the parents device. Select "yes" and enter the pairing code from earlier then select "next."
- Create a pin that is easy to remember and then accept the permissions from the app
- Once everything is accepted, head over to the parent device and tap on the "pair device" button
- Once the device is paired you are free to set up a time limit for the child's phone

Internet Service Provider's

AT&T

- Via a web browser login to your AT&T Wireless Internet Network
- Once logged in, click on "Parental Controls" and then click on the checkbox next to the desired device
- Once the checkbox is clicked, select "edit" and feel free to add new websites or restrict websites from being used. You can also select "Restricted Time Settings" to set a time of day in which the device is restricted from being used.

Comcast/Xfinity

- Log in to your router's administration site
- Click on "Select A Computer/Device" to choose a computer that is connected through the home network
- Check on the "Add" button on the computer you want to limit use on
- Under the "Days to Block" section check off the box under the day (or days) you want to limit. Under the "Time of Day" section, you can choose both a starting time and an ending time in which you can limit use
- Select "apply" to save all changes

Time Warner Cable

- McAfee Security Suite is the one who provides parental controls for Time Warner Cable. Registering for Security Suite allows you to download and install the parental controls

Verizon

- You can set up parental controls via the "My Fios" app if you have a Fios Quantum Gateway or a Fios Advanced Wi-Fi Router
- Through the app, select "Internet" followed by "Manage My Devices" and then "Devices and Parental Controls" allowing you to select a device you want to manage.
